2022: BOUNCE BACK TO IN-PERSON

From 2020 to early 2022, we did all of our weekly programming online. The shift to an online environment as a response to COVID-19 impacted our programming greatly. The engagement was difficult and attendance was low. In summer 2022, we started our inperson programming our Elders and Youth. Both were an immediate success:

HOUSING FIRST

In 2022, we expanded our housing efforts when we secured funding from the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families to pilot a Housing First project in La Crosse County. We worked with local and statewide advocates and stakeholders to develop a funding distribution system that is equitable and grounded in our principles of housing safety and stability for survivors of domestic violence. Housing First helps clients on a first-come, first-serve basis for housing-related emergencies, emphasizing maximizing other existing agency or community resources for non-urgent or targeted financial assistance whenever possible. 2022 was our pilot year, and it was a huge success:

2023: LOOKING AHEAD

Cia Siab, Inc.'s works to cultivate community wellness for Hmong people so that they are in positions to empower themselves, self-advocate, and lead. There is so much to do, with so little time, so little people power, and so little resources. As such, we employ a variety of approaches to build community wellness. This year, we want to prioritize a few approaches:

- Develop and expand housing equity for BIPOC in La crosse area for 2023.
 - Work with our community partners to improve zoning in La Crosse County
- Expand programming for youth, adults, and elders to build community
 - Secure additional funds
 - Add an additional day of elders programming
 - Grow our volunteer and donor base by introducing more people to our work
- Enhance holistic wellness in our communities through land-based environmental education and social justice outreach and training
 - Foster culturally-appropriate hate violence prevention and education trainings
 - Continue civic engagement work in the Hmoob community
